Student Technology Insurance Program
Grades 9th-12th

Owasso Public Schools Student Technology Insurance Program has been established to give parents the ability to purchase insurance for the 1:1 Instructional Initiative technology for the 2019-2020 school year. The technology given to the student includes a Chromebook and charger cord. The insurance, if purchased, will cover the repair or replacement costs of each part of the Chromebook as shown below. **The cost for the Insurance during the 2019-2020 school year is \$25 per student.** Students are expected to return their Chromebook and charging cord at the end of their Senior school year and/or if they leave the district prior to graduating in full working condition in order to avoid costs. The Student Technology Insurance Program is a voluntary program and families are highly encouraged, but not required, to participate. You will pay insurance or sign the form opting out of insurance prior to picking up your child's schedule the week before school. Insurance coverage, if purchased, will be from date of issue through the last day of Summer 2020. If your student is 10th-12th grade for the 2018-2019 school year and the insurance is not repurchased before the start of the 2019-2020 school year the coverage will end the last day of summer 2019.

No refunds. No prorating.

Insurance Plan Coverage:

If purchased, the Student Technology Insurance Program covers the technology package items as follows:

- 100% of the FIRST incident of damage
- 50% of the SECOND incident of damage
- 0% of any additional incident of damage

After two incidents, the parent/guardian is responsible for all repairs and replacement costs.

**Student Technology Insurance Program claims of theft must include a completed police/school resource officer report and be signed by a parent/guardian.

Evidence of intentional damage will not be covered by the insurance.

If purchasing insurance, it must be purchased before device is issued to the student and he/she takes possession. Once a student has been issued their device, it is NOT possible to purchase insurance.

Chromebook Distribution Schedule

August 13, 2019 - Schedule Pick-up for 10th and 12th graders. Must pay insurance or sign "opt out" form.

August 15, 2019 - Schedule Pick-up for 9th and 11th graders. Must pay insurance or sign "opt out" form.

August 19, 2019 - Freshman Chromebook Pick-up - 8am-2pm

August 20, 2019 - Freshman Chromebook Pick-up - 8am-2pm

August 21, 2019 - Returning Sophmores, Juniors and Seniors can bring their broken Chromebooks anytime between 8am and 12pm to turn them in to be repaired. They will be issued a Loaner Chromebook to start the 1st day of school with.

Please note: Freshman Chromebook Pick-up is completely optional. The idea is that your freshman will have their device in hand and fully charged to start the first day of school. If you are not able to come either of those days, your student will receive their device during the first week of school.
