



## ADMISSION POLICY

The Primary Focus of Robstown Early College High School is to help students overcome barriers to college access and to provide students from underrepresented backgrounds (i.e. at-risk, low income and/or first generation college attendees) the opportunity to earn up to 60 college credits free of charge while attending high school. The Texas Education Agency requires that designated Early College High Schools (ECHS) target students from underrepresented backgrounds; however, we encourage students of all backgrounds to apply.

Students must be enrolled at Robstown Independent School District (ISD) in Grade 8 to be considered. The opportunities that come with an Early College High School are available to any Robstown ISD student that meets the criteria listed below:

1. The student must have a desire to be a part of the ECHS program and must complete an electronic application. Assistance shall be made available for any student/parent that requests it.
2. The student's parent and/or guardian must want their child to be part of the program.
3. Both the parent/guardian and the student must agree to a 4 year commitment in the program.
4. Both the parent/guardian and the student must agree to abide by the standards of academic and behavioral expectations of Robstown ISD.
5. Both the parent/guardian and the student must agree to comply with all of the policies of the program.
6. Both parent/guardian and the student must agree that the ultimate goal is to graduate from Robstown ECHS with an associate's degree and/or up to 60 college credit hours.

Note: In accordance with the Texas Education Agency rules for ECHS Blueprint Benchmark 1, academics, discipline, state assessments and or teacher recommendations cannot be considered in the selection process.
