ABOUT CHRISSY'S CLOSET

Chrissy's Closet is a free store for CSISD students to obtain new/gently used clothes, shoes, underwear, socks, coats, and personal hygiene items. Nearly 35% of CSISD's population qualifies for Free or Reduced Lunch. This means 4,785 students may not have access to items needed to arrive at school clean, warm, and ready to learn. Currently, 134 of our students are considered homeless. Our goal is to help students and their families to feel positively about themselves, CSISD, and attending school. Chrissy's Closet is a part of the CSISD Education Foundation which is a non-profit, tax-exempt 501 (c) (3) public corporation. Tax-deductible gifts made to the foundation provide funds for opportunities above and beyond the normal operating budget of the school district which are not available through tax revenues. Chrissy's Closet opened on October 3, 2016.

WHERE IS CHRISSY'S CLOSET AND WHO CAN SHOP THERE?

Chrissy's Closet is located at College View High School, 1300 George Bush Drive in room 156 & the entrance is off of Timber Street. Any current student (& their parents) or employee of CSISD is eligible to shop at Chrissy's Closet.

WHAT & HOW MUCH CAN A STUDENT/EMPLOYEE SHOP FOR AT CHRISSY'S CLOSET?

Per month:

- Four clothing items per student/employee
- 2 toiletries (deodorant, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, soap, toilet paper or toothbrush)
- 1 package underwear per student/employee
- 1 package socks per student/employee

Per semester:

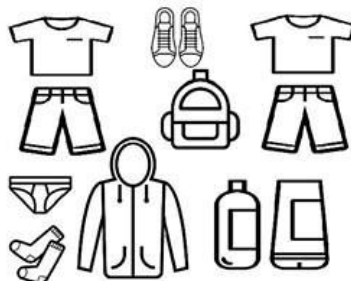
- 1 jacket/coat per semester
- 1 pair of NEW shoes per student/employee per semester

Donations may be brought all week! You will receive a COUPON at the time of the donation. This will be turned in on Friday for a stamp to wear your hat/sunglasses.



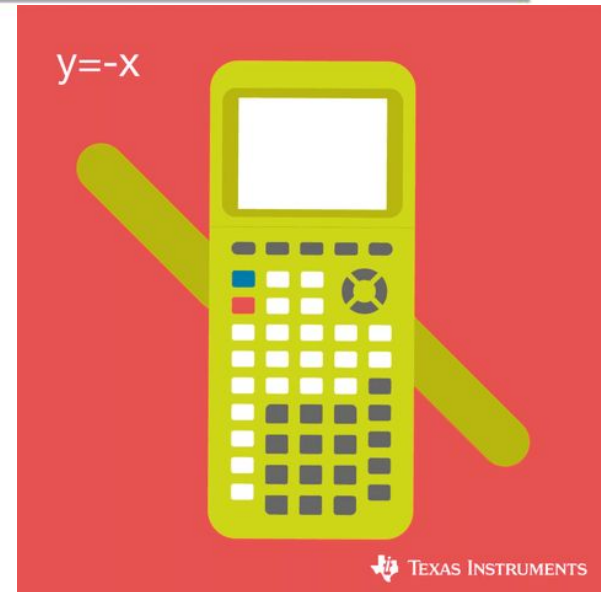
