## Action Plan for the 2018-19 School Year Presented to Board

Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum & Instruction Vikki Curry presented a detailed action plan for the 2018-19 school year to the COCISD Board of Trustees on Tuesday, Aug. 28.

“As a district, we have work to do,” said Curry.

After an overview of the rating system and campus scores, Curry discussed campus audits and data reviews that revealed pockets of areas where COCISD students struggle, mainly English and Language Arts at the elementary and junior high levels.

The action plan includes

curriculum alignment with a focus on targeted areas that need improvement.

A team of instructional coaches will provide trainings for teachers in TEKS Resources, small group instruction, and literacy circles, as well as instructional content, lesson planning and delivery.

## Coldspring-Oakhurst High School offers Chromebooks 1:1

Coldspring-Oakhurst High School students can check out Chromebooks to use for their entire high school career as part of the new 1:1 computer loan-out program. Designed to equip students with skills they will need in a technology-driven work force, the program provides computers they can use both at school and at home. No internet at home is required as long as students work on downloaded projects.

Chromebooks are available for checkout at the high school library. Students and their parents/guardians must complete a form and submit a \$50 (or \$20 down) deposit for checkout.
