

# Moanalua Middle School

## 2019 Summer Enrichment Course Descriptions\*

### **BAND 1 (Beginning)**

This course covers the fundamentals of reading music and playing different musical instruments. Previous musical training is not required, but students should have music aptitude. An aptitude test may be administered at the beginning of the course.

### **BAND II (Intermediate)**

This course involves a deeper study and performance of both classical and contemporary literature. There will be greater emphasis on the achievement of proficient techniques and mature musicianship in solo, ensemble, and full-band performance. Prior experience is needed.

### **ORCHESTRA I**

This class is required for all NEW (7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade), incoming students to the orchestra program who want to take orchestra during the 2019-2020 school year. This class is recommended for students with 2 or less years of experience on their instrument – if they already play a string orchestra instrument. Students can be in this class with no experience. If you had a scheduled audition already, you would've been told whether or not you needed to take this class AND/OR the Orchestra II class. ### **ORCHESTRA II (Intermediate)**

This class is for students who successfully completed orchestra at MMS in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade and want to sharpen their skills during the summer time. It will also introduce students to some of the technical skills needed to play in the upper level orchestra classes. It is NOT required for continuing students, but highly recommended.

### **SPORTS & GAMES “ULTIMATE”**

This summer we will be learning about physical fitness, which will have students actively participate in team sports. The focus of this class will be on team work, requiring students work with one another while competing in a variety of different sports and outdoor activities. Some of the activities that we will be doing this summer include: Ultimate Frisbee, Handball, Basketball and Volleyball.

### **INTRODUCTION TO JAPANESE**

This course is intended to introduce the Japanese language and culture to students. As an introductory class, students will learn how to write in katakana and hiragana. Students will also learn basic vocabulary and phrases. Numbers and time are also included in the course. Japanese culture such as foods and customs will also be discussed.

### **BEGINNING UKULELE**

An introductory ukulele class for the courageous and/or curious student – learn to read and play basic chords, develop strumming variations and rhythms, and play contemporary/popular instrumental songs. Bring your own ukulele or you may borrow one of ours.

### **SMILE STYLE - DANCE**

The purpose of “Smile Style” is to uplift, inspire, and educate your child to be healthy and physically active through dance. This class will focus on hip hop and Latin dance and creative movement. Explore your freedom of expression through a fun and explosive high energy dance class.

### **LANGUAGE ARTS STUDIO**

Have you ever been stuck trying to start an essay? Would you like to build your confidence in reading? Maybe you want to simply get ahead and sharpen up language arts skills for next year. In this course, we'll be focusing on how to develop better reading skills, how to write and organize an essay, and how to become a more confident speaker. We will also explore various related topics such as poetry and creative writing.

### **MATH ENRICHMENT**

This course will focus on building upon the main mathematical domain skills outlined in the Common Core State Standards with the use of project-based learning. Project-based learning promotes teamwork, problem-solving skills, and critical thinking.

ALL CLASSES are first come, first served. ALL CLASSES subject to closure/cancellation depending on enrollment counts. Unless the student is notified of NOT being enrolled in class due to over or under enrollment, the student is to assume he/she has been registered. A student will not be registered if all forms are incomplete.

## SUMMER ENRICHMENT ~ DRESS CODE POLICY

Though a strict dress code policy is not enforced for this program, the Administrative Staff highly encourages you to review the school's **standard dress code policy** below with your child(ren) to ensure that certain dress guidelines are met.

Because this program is a direct extension of Moanalua Middle School, the school strives to create a place for learning, and students are expected to dress in good taste without becoming a distraction to others. Student's attire should reflect the message of a safe and drug-free campus.

### **STANDARD DRESS CODE:**

Hats, visors and sunglasses are not to be worn or visible on campus, except for approved field trips or physical education activities. Any item of clothing that may be construed as gang-related or items disruptive to the school environment may be banned or confiscated.

Boys' pants and shorts must fit at the waist without the support of a belt. (If trousers are falling down without the use of a belt, they are considered too large!) Sagged or baggy pants, loose or hanging belts or chains, and torn jeans are inappropriate attire for middle school. Pants should have pockets so that valuables may be secured in a pocket instead of in a backpack.

Girls may wear a variety of tops including t-shirts, polo shirts, or blouses – as long as the top is tucked in or worn out extending below the waistline, with no visible midriff or cleavage. Girls' shorts inseam must fall mid-thigh in length. Dresses and skirts (short/long) will be considered inappropriate attire. Halter, tank, cropped, single sided or tube tops; cut shirts, spaghetti straps, torn jeans; and clothing that is see-through, reveals underwear, is body hugging, or bares the midriff are **unacceptable**. For safety reasons, girls should not wear high-heeled shoes.
