2017-20 Proposed Local Control Funding Formula/Local Control and Accountability Plan - Year Two Feedback Form

In 2013, California adopted a new funding structure for school districts, called the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF). The LCFF also changed district's accountability for unrestricted funding in the form of a three-year Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP), which includes actions/services for student outcomes. The State has identified eight priorities that must be addressed in the LCAP document. The services provided to students must align to one or more of the Eight State Priorities. Districts are required to use state and local metrics to inform the district and public of their progress towards goals outlined in the LCAP. The District has engaged stakeholders in the review, implementation, monitoring and development of the LCAP document. The draft 2017-20 LCFF/LCAP-Year Two provides the recommended priorities for the district based on the Eight State Priorities. In an effort to seek ongoing feedback, we are providing you with the opportunity to complete a brief survey.
