- e. Print the results immediately and email a copy to yourself.

3. **Assessments in Naviance Student**--located in the “About Me” section:

- b. MI Advantage (Intelligence inventory; gives natural abilities)

- e. Career Interest Profiler
- f. Career Cluster Finder

4. **Junior College & Career Presentation**—This is a culmination of research done by evaluating the assessments completed. The goal is to find career(s) that pop up in multiple assessments and research at least one career to discover how this career fits with who they are as an individual. Is it a good fit? The research will continue with searching for colleges that offer the major that will lead towards that career path.
