BOO Grams

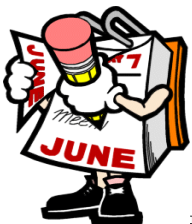

Teacher's Corner

5th grade Science

Fifth graders just finished their unit on Physical Properties Of Matter. We investigated density, solubility, mass, magnetism, and electrical conductivity. Students created circuits to test conductors and insulators, measured mass on triple beam balances, and tested the properties of a copper penny. Ask your student about solubility and how to test it. (Hint: you can use salt and water at home!)
