Permission to drive onto campus is a privilege that Highland Hall may revoke at any time in its sole discretion. Students must park only in the high school parking lot; they may not park on Amestoy or any other street.

PARENTAL PERMISSION AND RELEASE OF CLAIMS: My child has permission to drive onto campus. By agreeing to permit my child to drive onto campus, I am also agreeing to release the School from all claims that might arise out of my child's driving. This release includes claims for injury or damage, except when caused by the willful misconduct or sole negligence of Highland Hall. The "School" shall mean Highland Hall and includes its teachers, employees, sponsors, chaperones, students, parents and volunteers.

I understand that, on behalf of my child and myself, I am giving up claims for injury and loss, and that I am giving up the right to sue for, among other things, negligence and bodily injury.
