

## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

**Courses will be taught only if there is sufficient enrollment. If a course is cancelled, money will be refunded to the parent/guardian. Fees are not refundable unless a course cancellation occurs.**

Students have the option to work from home or come into school based on the individual summer school teacher's schedule. Students **WILL BE** required to come the **FIRST** day to one session to check in with their teachers on **July 1st**.

**Parents are asked to attend an informational meeting the first day with the students before the session starts in the auditorium promptly at 8:30 AM.**

Teachers will explain the format and structure of their course, as well as answer any questions.

Please enclose the attached registration form, financial assistance application (if applicable) and a **money order** made payable to Armstrong School District by **June 26th**. **We are only accepting money orders or cash.**

### Summer School Format:

- Students may **ONLY** sign up for a maximum of 2 courses that have been failed with a minimum of 50%. No acceleration of courses!
- Students are able to work from home.
- Students may come in and work directly with the summer school teacher on their specific days starting week 2. The time will be 9-11am Monday through Thursday at West Shamokin's library. Armstrong High School's library will **ONLY** be open for use of the computers from 9-11 am Monday through Thursday. No teachers will be at Armstrong High School these days.
- An extra math tutoring session will be added on Fridays 9-11 at Armstrong High School as needed for students who are failing.
- Students must log in with their on-line courses or the teacher will contact them.
- **New this year for math:** Any student with a failing grade in math after week 2 **MUST** come in for one tutoring session the following week. The math course will be paused until they attend tutoring. If a student does not attend tutoring, the student will be given a failing grade.
- **New: For a student to take a summer school course, they must have achieved a minimum of 50% as their final course grade.**
- Summer school will **ONLY** be remediation this year.
- **Armstrong School District will not provide computers or technology for use during summer school. Students may come into the building during designated hours to utilize Armstrong School District technology.**

### Cost:

### Session Options:

The library at Armstrong and West Shamokin will be open from 9-11am everyday from Monday to Thursday. Teachers will report to West Shamokin during these times. The schedule of teachers will be provided the first day of orientation. An extra math session will be added as needed at Armstrong High School 9-11 am on Fridays.

### Schedule:

Course work will be five weeks: from July 1st through August 2nd. **The schools will be closed on July 4th.**

### Requirements:

Students MUST report the first day of summer school for orientation to go over the course requirements.

Students MUST log in to their courses everyday. Teachers will contact parents if they are falling behind on work or not logging in.

Teachers will be available for 2 hours once a week at West Shamokin Jr/Sr High school library. Each teacher will have a designated day for office hours.

The library at Armstrong Jr/Sr High will also be open 9-11 am Monday through Thursday for students who need to use the computer. No teachers will be at this building.
