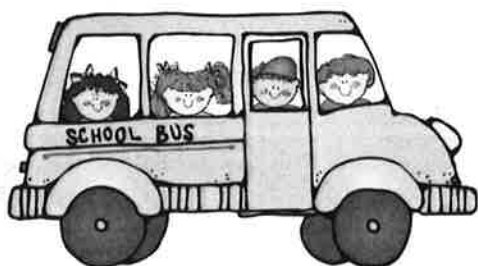
Box Tops for Education
