Subject: Proposed Fundraisers for 2016-2017

Date: July 19, 2016

The Oneida Middle School request approval for the following proposed fundraisers for the 2015-2016 school year:

- School-Wide Fundraiser for 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Trip: Great American Opportunities
- **Vending Machines – Bottle Water is available to the students except during the lunch period. Profit is approximately 40% with \$1 per case flex fund. All direct profits are deposited into the general-purpose fund. The flex fund monies are deposited in the incentive account.**
- Healthy Snacks Project – During breaks and special events healthy snacks will be sold to the students with the profits being deposited into the incentive program. The cost of these snacks will be recycled to purchase additional snacks to be sold. This should be a perpetual project.
- Concessions – Concessions for the football and basketball seasons:
  - Football - All sports teams' sign up to work the concession stand for a home ballgame. Profit is divided based on the number of games worked.
  - Basketball – All sports teams' sign up to work the concession stand for a home ballgame. Profit is divided based on the number of games worked.
- School supplies are sold in the office and the proceeds are deposited into the general purpose fund. **Most supplies are sold at approximately what they are purchased for plus taxes and shipping.**
- Others: We would like permission to have other fundraisers such as doughnut sales, school t-shirts, soft serve ice cream, and car washes as needed. Several local businesses make space and water available at no charge for the car washes. Doughnut sales have been done very successfully. The profit on a doughnut sale can be between 50-56%.
- A "Fundraiser Authorization" will be submitted to the board for approved fundraisers before the fundraiser **begins.**
