DANCE CONTRACT

Our goal in the implementation of these guidelines is the creation of a safe and fun environment in which our students can enjoy themselves in an appropriate and legal manner. Students that violate the following guidelines will face the consequences as outlined below.

1. Dances are open to all eligible Bordentown Regional High School students. By eligibility, it is understood that the student is eligible as it relates to attendance, grades, and discipline.
2. Some dances will allow the opportunity for a BRHS student to bring a guest. A host student may sponsor only one (1) other high school-aged student. Any guest must be 20 years old or younger on the date of the dance. There may be no exception to this rule. The host student is responsible for the behavior of his/her guest. All students/guests will be required to show *photo identification* before granted admittance.
3. All students must be present in school on the day of the dance to be eligible to attend the dance that night.
4. No student will be admitted to a dance one hour after the dance has started.
5. Any student who leaves the dance early will not be permitted back on school grounds and the student's parents will be contacted immediately.
6. All school rules apply during the dance. Cell phones and cameras are permissible.
7. If a student is suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or a drug, a parent will be called to take him/her for further drug/alcohol tests [District Policy #5131.61 and #5131.62]. BRHS reserves the right to use a breathalyzer.
8. The modified school dress code policy will be in effect. Thin-shouldered, strapless dresses and halter tops may be worn. Very short dresses (generally must be longer than one's fingertips when arms are fully extended) will not be permitted. Attire will be deemed as appropriate or inappropriate by the school administration.
9. Any damage to the DJ's equipment will be the responsibility of the student, who will be solely liable for these costs.
10. All dance styles must comply with standards of safety, modesty and appropriate school-age behavior. The chaperones and administrator in attendance will be the final judge of the appropriateness of the dance style. *Inappropriate dancing is defined by any overtly sexual or suggestive movements that mimics or emulate sexual acts or motions or otherwise dangerous dancing. Inappropriate dancing includes, but is not limited to, slam dancing, moshing, freaking, booty dancing (including prone, crotch-to-crotch, grinding, juking, and "train" or "sandwich" dancing). No touching or pretending to touch the buttocks, pelvic region or breasts.*
11. Failure to follow the above dance guidelines will result in the following consequences.
 - *1st offense: a verbal warning along with signing in with the administrator.*
 - *2nd offense: he/she will be removed from the dance and brought into a holding area for a time frame of 30 to 60 minutes before returning to the dance*
 - *3rd offense: he/she will escorted out of the dance and will not be permitted back in for the remainder of the time. His/her parent/guardian will be called to pick him/her up from the dance. Student will be banned from the next scheduled dance, including Prom.*

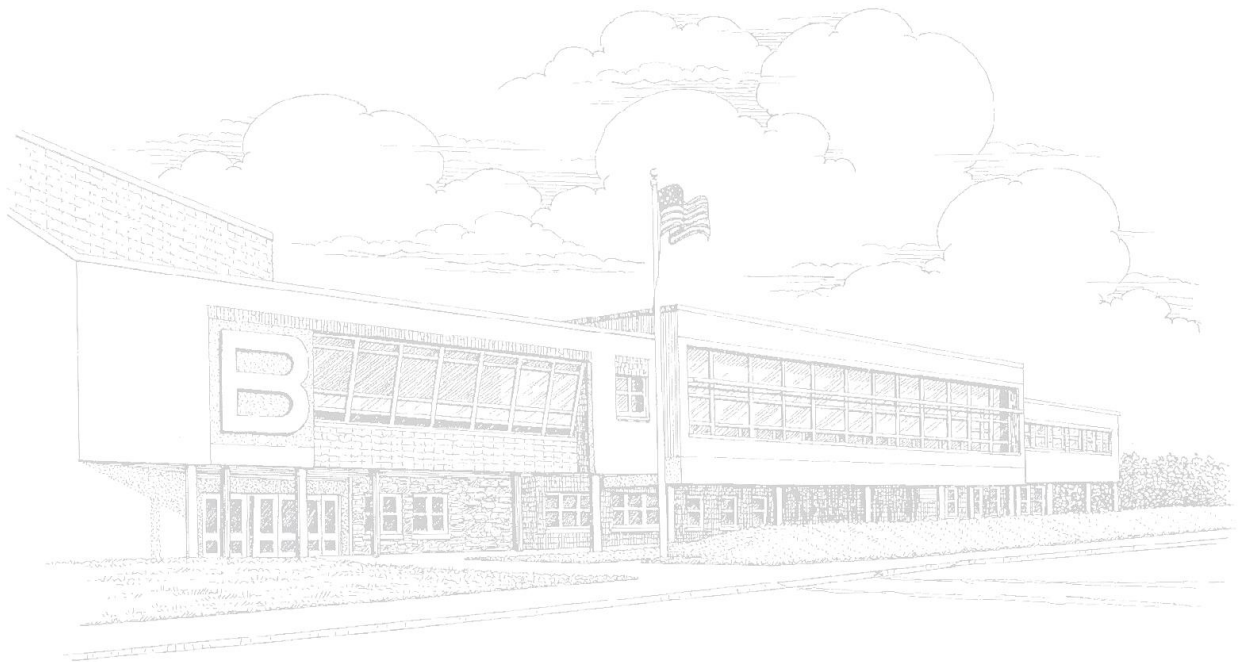
