

Business and Noninstructional Operations

Expenditures/Expending Authority

The Governing Board shall establish and maintain an adequate reserve. The district's annual expenditures shall not exceed its annual income.

The Superintendent or designee may purchase supplies, materials and equipment in accordance with Board policy and administrative regulations. Such purchases shall not exceed the limits imposed by law. All such transactions shall be reviewed by the Board every 60 days. (Education Code 39657)
