## Scholarship Guidelines

The following guidelines were established to cover the annual scholarships to be presented by the East Bernard FFA Booster Club. All criteria and deadlines will be strictly enforced to provide a consistent evaluation process.

- 1) The applicant must be a graduating senior of East Bernard High School. The applicant must be an active member of the East Bernard FFA and member in good standing. Consideration will be given to transfer students that meet the same requirements while attending East Bernard High School.
- 2) The applicant must have participated in East Bernard FFA activities such as SAE's, LDE's, and CDE's.
- 3) Parent (s) needs to be an active member and a member (s) in good standing of the East Bernard FFA Booster Club.
- 4) The applicant must be a college or vocational school bound student.
- 5) The applicant must write an essay of a minimum of 200 words on topic specified on application form. The essay must be turned in with the application.
- 6) The completed application must be turned in by **specified date**. **NO late applications will be accepted.** (with all required signatures)
- 7) The completed application form along with the essay should be **turned into the FFA Advisors**. The application will be reviewed by a committee of three East Bernard FFA Booster Club members (who do not have a child applying).
- 8) The applicant must show proof of enrollment at college or vocational school of choice within one (1) year of graduation from high school to receive the scholarship amount.
- 9) The scholarship recipients will be presented at the East Bernard High School FFA end of the year awards banquet.
- 10) Please include additional pages if needed.
- 11) This scholarship is based on a 100 point score.
