CAASPP Testing Calendar explanation:

- The **schedule progresses in a two day rotation**. For example, “Period 1” will be the FIRST period of the day for TWO days (with Per. 2 testing), then Per. 3 will be testing for the following two days WITH ALL OTHER PERIODS REMAINING THE SAME. This test period rotation will continue until June 3 when Per. 1 tests for two periods to conclude the testing calendar. Please refer to the testing schedule for the rest of the rotation to ensure you and your child is aware of the rotating testing schedule.
- The **SECOND Period** of the day is ALWAYS the “**TESTING PERIOD**” highlighted in GOLD in the testing schedule.
- The “**Testing Period**” is 2 Hours in length, compared to 44 mins for the rest of the periods in the day.
- **NO Late Wednesday** schedules during testing period (school starts @ 7:45 AM on 5/22 & 5/29).
- **Zero & Seventh Periods** will remain the same (unchanged from the regular school schedule).
- **Absent students** or those who couldn't complete the administered portion of the proctored exam will be pulled into the “makeup” room in the College Career Center to complete their testing.

If you are an:

11TH GRADER:

- If “**Testing Period**” is **ENGLISH**, you will take the CAASPP English Language Arts (ELA) in the TWO DAYS of testing.
 - English Portion should take no more than **4 hours total**.
 - Zero Period: Jepsen’s AP Language students will test during zero period.
- If “**Testing Period**” is **MATH**, you will take the CAASPP Math in the TWO DAYS of testing.
 - Math portion should take no more than **4 hours total**.
- If “**Testing Period**” is **US HISTORY**, you will take the CAST (Science Test) on One DAY of the two testing days.
 - Science portion should take no more than **2 hours total**.

If you are an:

12TH GRADER:

- If “**Testing Period**” is **ENGLISH**, you will take the CAST (Science Test) on One DAY of the two testing days.
 - Science portion should take no more than **2 hours total**.

MAKE UP TEST: Students will be pulled out to test in the Library and/or C3 if they have not completed their portion of their exam. Students may miss valuable instruction in other classes on this day to complete state testing (CAASPP and/or CAST), so PLEASE TRY YOUR BEST TO NOT MISS ANY TESTING DAYS FOR YOUR Student.
