

1 **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

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3 THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING SETS FORTH THE FOLLOWING AGREEMENT  
4 BETWEEN PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES OF WASHINGTON/SEIU LOCAL #1948,  
5 CENTRAL VALLEY CHAPTER AND THE CENTRAL VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT #356. THIS  
6 AGREEMENT IS ENTERED INTO PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XXII, SECTION 22.3 OF THE  
7 CURRENT COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT.

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9 The parties agree:

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11 A joint study will be done in the early part of the 2018-2019 school year regarding the trip assignment  
12 process in the Transportation department to be reviewed by the Public School Employees (PSE) and  
13 Central Valley School District administration.

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15 The current practices result in frequent errors, miscommunication and often infringe on the rights of  
16 employees. The goal will be to study the current process, investigate the practices and successes of  
17 other transportation departments and recommend changes in how trip assignments are determined and  
18 processed.

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20 The committee will be made up of a team including:

- 21 • 2 bus drivers
- 22 • 1 Transportation Technician
- 23 • 1 Dispatcher
- 24 • 2 District representatives

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26 The goal of this committee will be to have a recommendation by February 15, 2019, that can be piloted  
27 for the remainder of the year and be brought to negotiations in order to be bargained.

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30 This Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective upon signatures; remain in effect until  
31 August 31, 2019; and will be attached to the current Collective Bargaining Agreement.
