Creating Trauma Sensitive Schools to Maximize the Learning Potential of All Students

This Trauma Sensitive Summit will provide educators with an increased understanding of how trauma affects the education of students. Keynote speaker, Ralph Rothacker from the Attachment and Trauma Network and current principal of St. Anne's Academy in Albany, NY, will speak from experience about working with challenging students who experienced great trauma, the effects of trauma on the brain, strategies to work with students, and a planning session for school teams to plan action steps toward becoming a trauma sensitive school. Breakout sessions will include a Restorative Justice introduction, Building Resiliency, Supporting Compassion Fatigued Teachers through Self-Care.
