

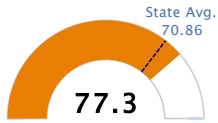

Overall ESSA Index Score



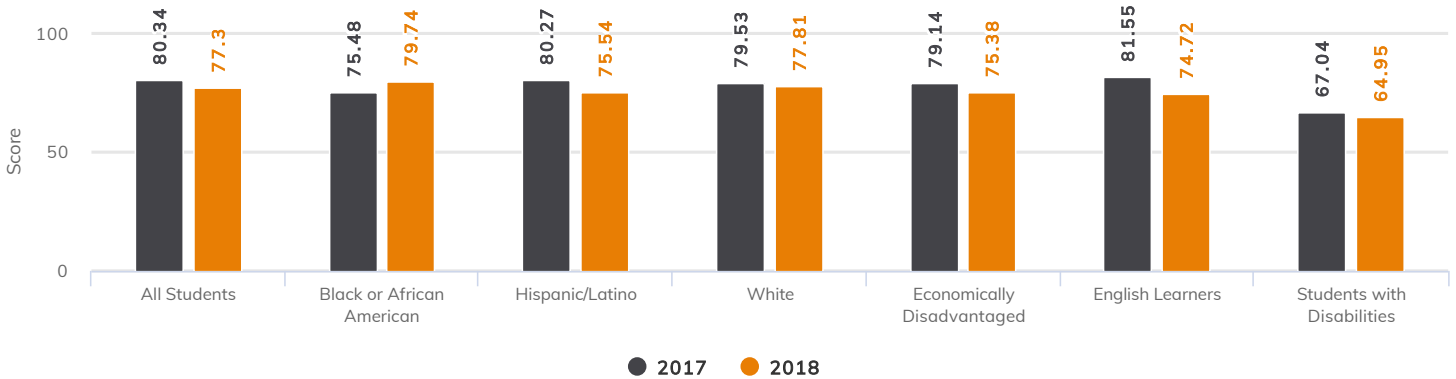

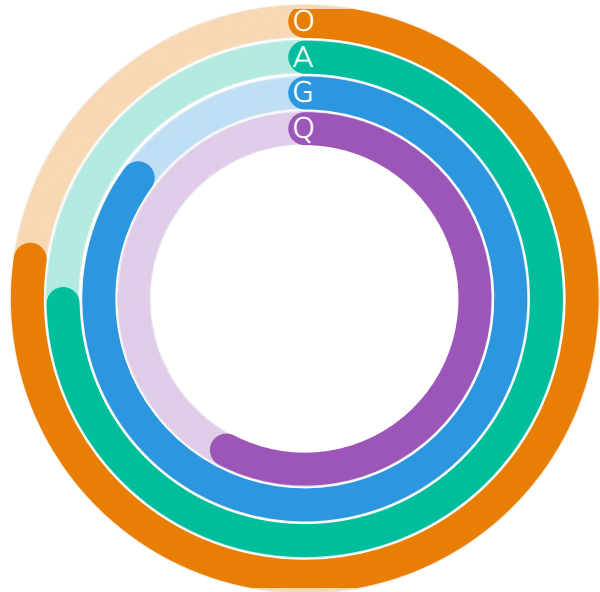

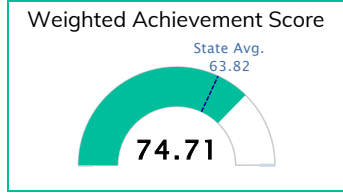

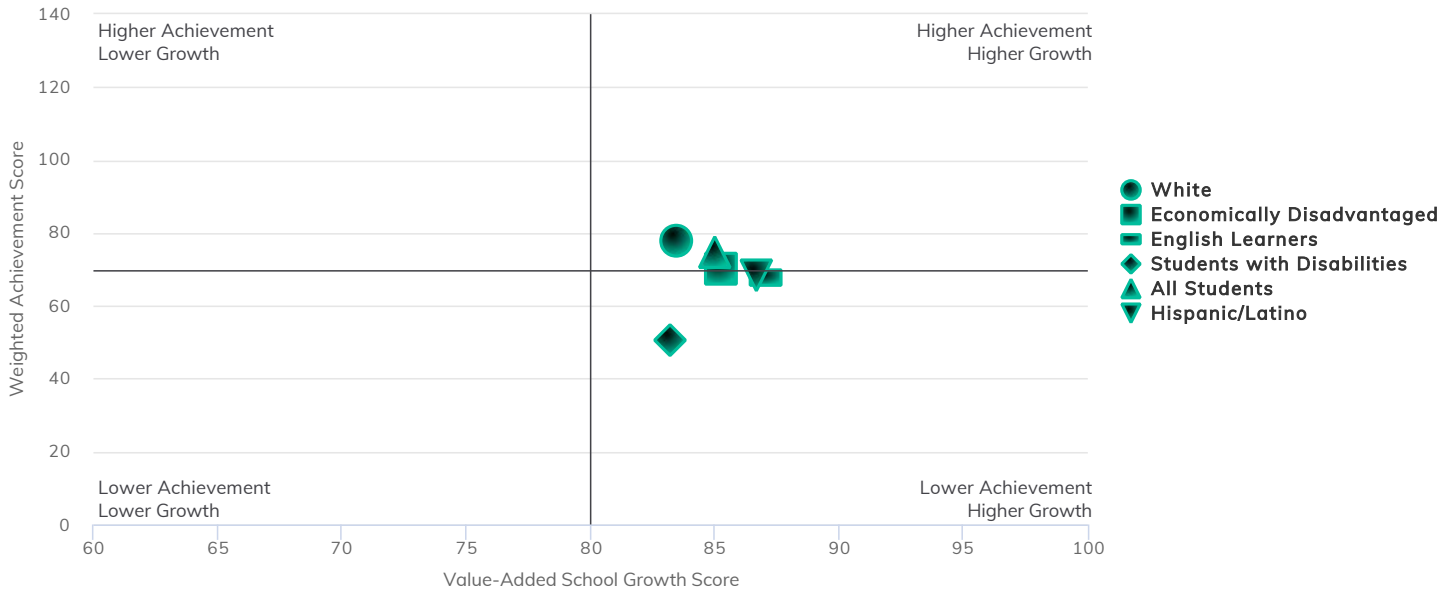

School Value-added Growth Score Plotted with Weighted Achievement for Subgroups

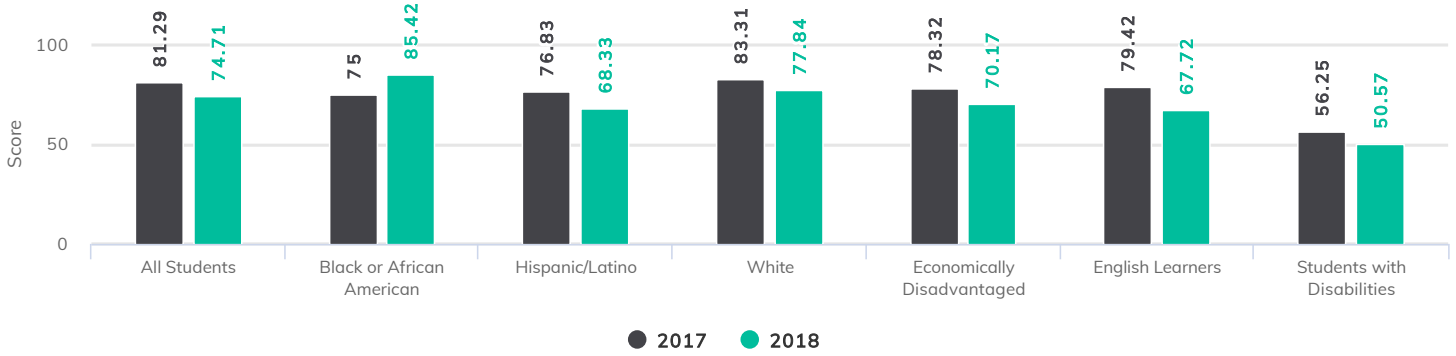

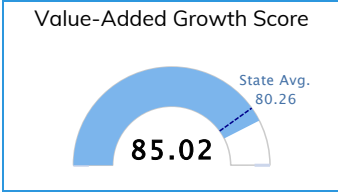

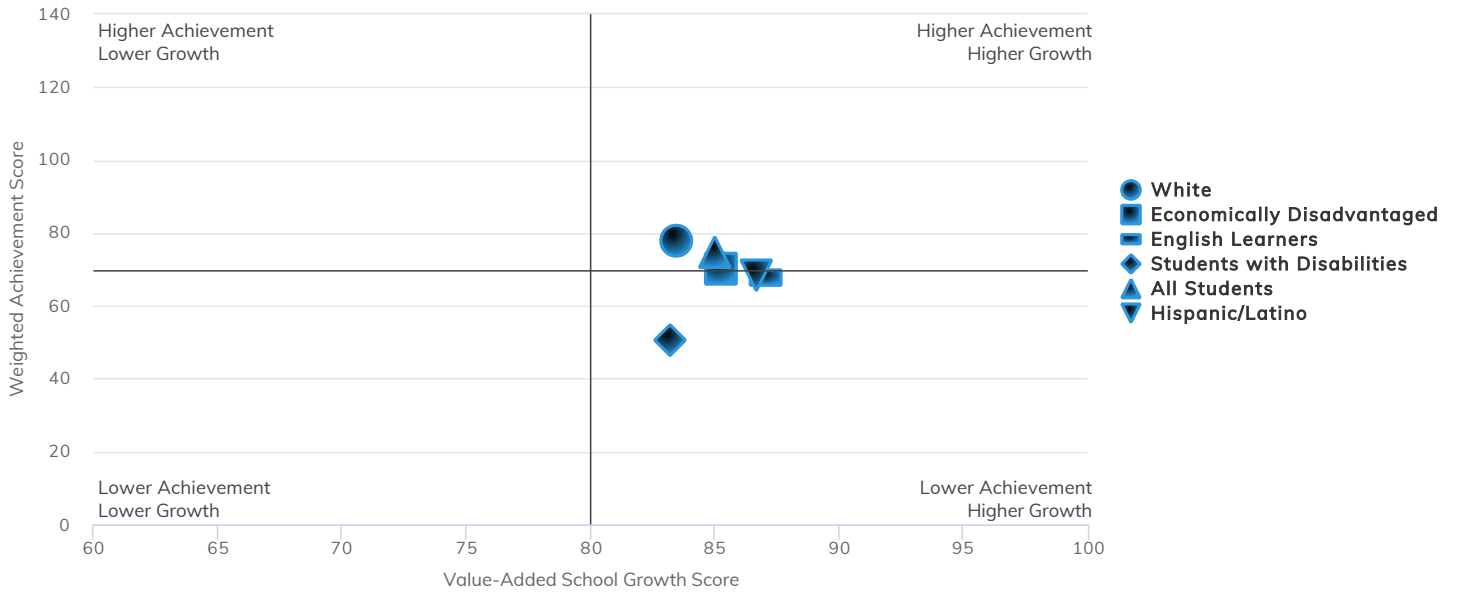

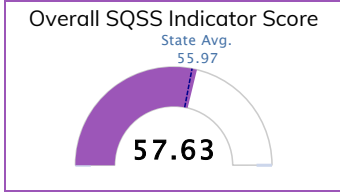

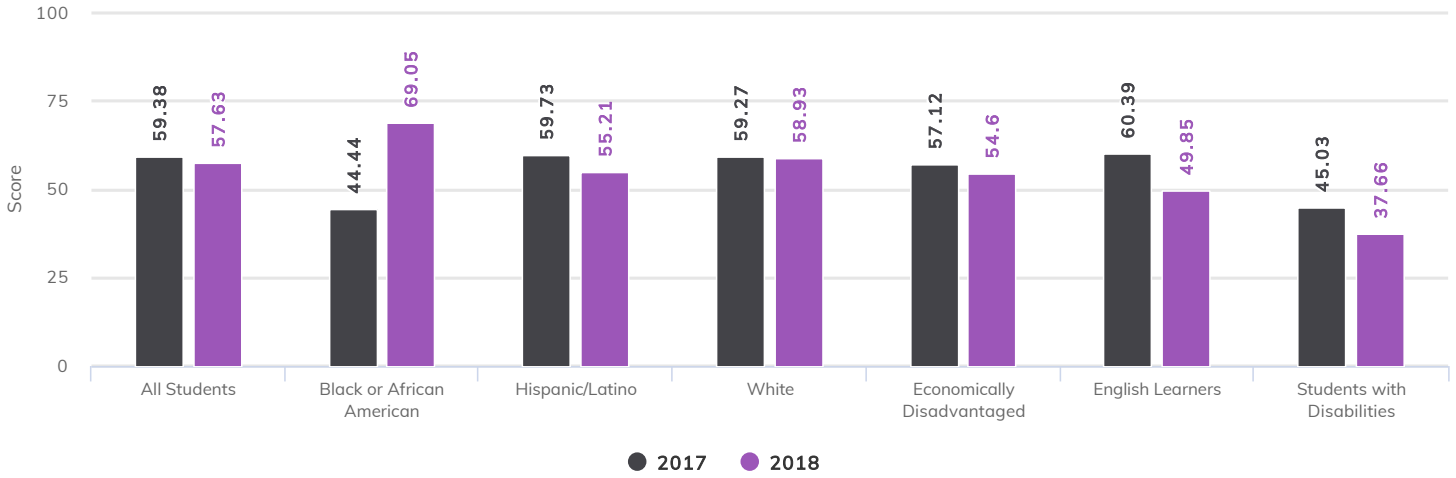

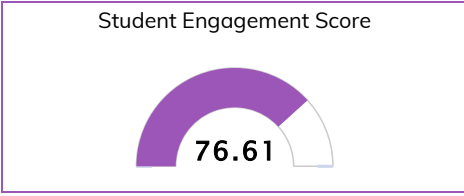

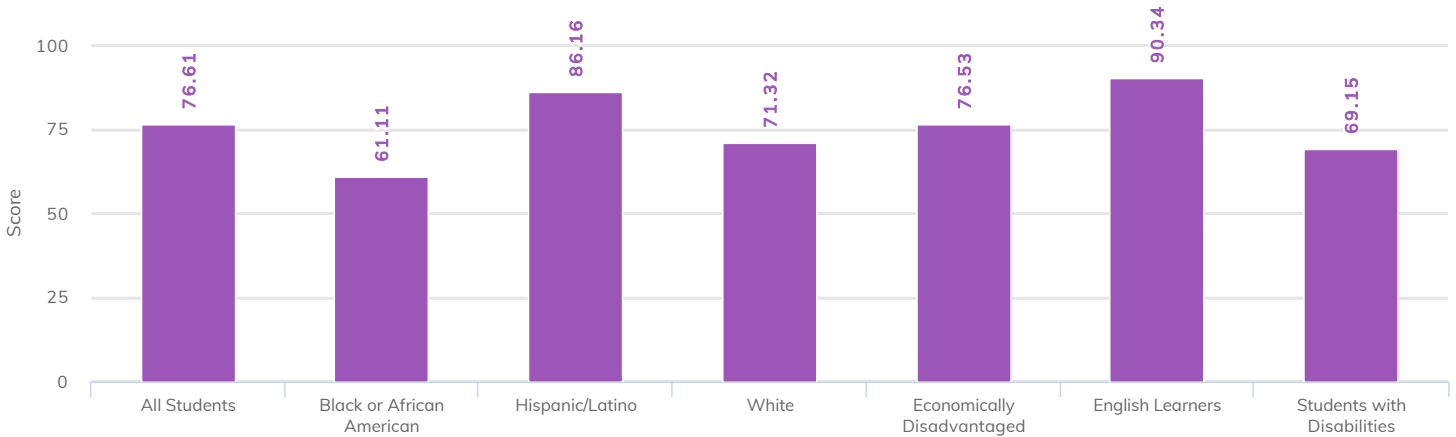

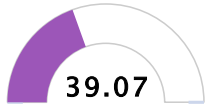

State Distribution of School-Level Reading at Grade Level

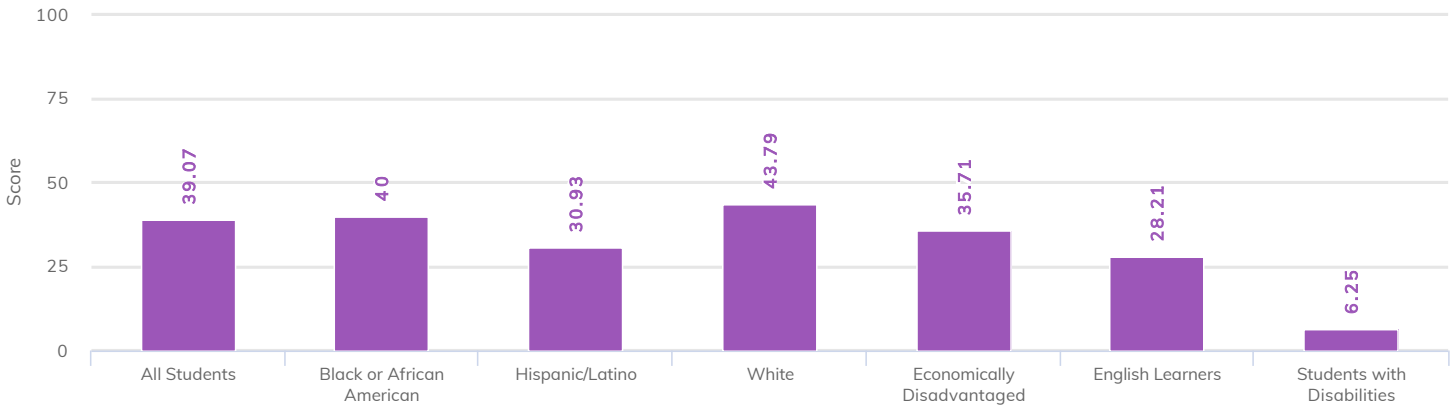

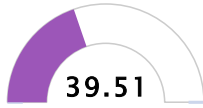

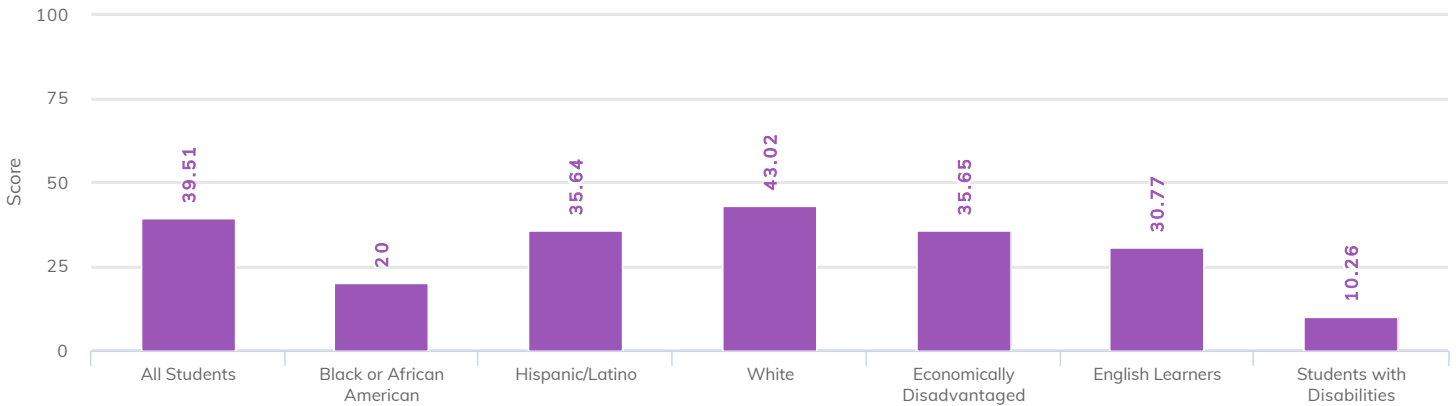

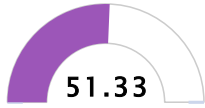
