This year's contest will be held during Fire Prevention Week and is open to all 1<sup>st</sup> thru 5<sup>th</sup> grade students in the Village of Libertyville and the Libertyville Fire Protection District.

Contest Rules:

- ★ All entries must incorporate the 2018 Fire Prevention Week theme. This year's theme is:

***"Look. Listen. Learn. Be Aware."***  
*"Fire Can Happen Anywhere"*

- ★ Entries may be submitted on poster board or paper. Maximum size 22" x 28". Any color is acceptable. NO 3-D posters (flat only.) Posters must be able to be hung on the wall without any material falling off.
  - ★ Each entry **MUST** have the student's full name, grade, school name, and teacher's name on the back of the poster.
- Deadline for entries is **Monday, October 8, 2018**.
- ★ Preliminary judging will be held at each school on **Wednesday, October 10, 2018**. Ribbons will be distributed for First and Second place winners. An Honorable Mention ribbon will be awarded in each grade in each school. Judging is done by members of the Libertyville Junior Women's Club and the Libertyville Fire Department.
  - ★ Trophies will be awarded to winners at each grade level for all posters entered. The poster that best depicts this year's theme will receive the grand prize trophy. The grand prize winner will be named at the Libertyville Fire Department's Open House festivities on Saturday, October 13th at Station #1, 1551 N. Milwaukee Avenue. All award winning posters will also be on display at the Open House.
- Posters will be returned to the schools and may be picked up after October 15<sup>th</sup>. The grand prize entry will be submitted for statewide competition held by the Illinois Fire Inspector's Association.
- ★ Ideas from parents are welcome, but all work should come from the children
