Summer School Policies & Procedures

The Tomball ISD secondary summer school program is designed to provide an opportunity for students to repeat courses failed. Make-up credits are offered through our self-paced Grad Lab, and it is possible for students to make up more than one semester of one course per session based on their efforts. Make-up credit is only available for repeat credit courses.

Who May Attend

Students enrolled in grades 8th-12th during the 2019-2020 school year may attend.

Curriculum

Courses will be offered for make-up credit for students in grades 7-12.

Transportation

Transportation is **NOT** provided for secondary summer school. However, there a shuttle from Tomball High School to Tomball Memorial High School will be provided. Students can sign up for the shuttle service during registration.
