Graduation Practices

- ❖ All performances/skits planned for the Graduation Ceremony are required to be rehearsed during the scheduled practices.

Dress Code

KHIS Practices - Adhere to KHIS Dress Code.

BYUH Practices - Adhere to KHIS Dress Code and BYUH Standards (No shorts above the knee, no tank tops, all tops need to cover shoulders, etc.).

*BYUH security has strictly enforced their rules in the past. Be prepared to go home or call home for a change of clothes.

Graduation Ceremony Preparation

- ❖ Be at BYUH by 3:45 pm in your Cap and Gown for the class picture (don't forget bobbi-pins to hold your cap in place).
- ❖ Food will be provided after taking the class picture.
- ❖ No decorating caps, no flags, t-shirts, etc.
- ❖ No unauthorized signs, flags, props, etc.
- ❖ No additional clothing to be worn over the gown; and no alterations to the gown. School issued medals, tassels, or stoles only.

Graduation Dress Code

Attire expected throughout the duration of the ceremony:

- ❖ Females: Red Gown, Red Cap, White Tassel, and White Stole.
Knee-length clothing and light-colored shoes/sandals.
- ❖ Males: White Gown, White Cap, Red Tassel, and Red Stole.
White dress shirt and dark-colored tie, dress pants, socks,
and shoes.

*No slippers, please.

Graduation Dress Code (continued)

- ❖ Keep gowns on/zipped up at all times and footwear on, unless part of the program.

*If necessary, student will be called off the stage to be reminded of these expectations.

Guest Rules

- ❖ Balloons, air-horns/noise makers, confetti poppers, not allowed during the ceremony. Bags will be checked by BYUH security.
- ❖ No stages/fireworks permitted in graduate greeting area.

Diplomas and Transcripts

- ❖ Official transcripts can be requested from the Registrar's Office to be mailed to your college, NCAA, military, or trade school once final grades are inputted.
- ❖ Diplomas can be picked up after June 3, 2019 from the Registrar's Office (students who pay for obligations with a check will need to wait until checks are cleared prior to picking up their diploma).
- ❖ If you would like your diploma mailed to you, provide a pre-stamped and self-addressed envelope to Q1.



Transferring Your Google Account

1. Your Google Account EXPIRES when you graduate
2. You need to create a “NEW FOLDER” and put all the documents you want to keep in it
3. “SHARE” this new folder with yourself on a different Gmail account (this may mean you need to create a new gmail...)
4. “ADD FOLDER TO YOUR DRIVE” on your new gmail
