



Important Information from the Wimberley ISD Transportation Department

As Wimberley ISD parents, guardians and family members prepare for the first day of school, we know that if you have a bus-rider in your household, you are navigating the registration process and also familiarizing yourself with bus routes. Here are some ways to make it go smoothly on the first day of school tomorrow, August 15.

1. Once you have registered your child with the school district, complete the bus transportation form online by clicking our [family access link](#). Please follow these instructions:

Click on returning student → Click on your child's name → on the right menu click on **Bus Route Registration** → Click **Edit Step 2 or Complete Step 2** on the bottom of the screen → Select one or both of the boxes under your child's name **Will Ride TO School and/or Will Ride FROM School** → then exit the screen.

2. View the bus routes on the [transportation link](#). Note: You will need your student's school ID number to view your bus route. The ID number is both the username and the password. Please allow 24 hours for processing before changes will appear.

Since this can be challenging and scary for our younger children, please be aware that Wimberley ISD bus drivers are ready to help you and your student. If you need help finding your student's school ID number, please contact the school registrar on your campus.
