Student's Academic Record

Application for Grade 1

- a) Unsatisfactory results on State assessments (DSTP)
- b) Teacher evaluation
- c) Homework is not consistently completed and/or returned
- d) School materials are not returned promptly and in good condition
- e) Parents are inconsistent in responding to teacher contacts about academic performance

Application for Grade 6 and for Grade 9

- a) Level I ("Well Below Standards") or Level II ("Below Standards") in the reading, or the mathematics portion of the Delaware Student Testing Program and Level I ("Well Below Standards") in the writing portion of the DSTP (if applicant has taken the DSTP) and/or
- b) Failing grades in English/language arts or mathematics (for previous and/or current year-to-date)

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Not academically eligible to participate in extracurricular activities (for previous and/or current year-to-date)

Student's Attendance Record

- a) Grades 6 – "Unsatisfactory" attendance grade(s) as reported on student progress report (for previous and/or current year-to-date)
- b) Grade 9 – Any combination of five tardies, three unexcused absences, and/or ten or more excused absences (for previous and/or current year-to-date)

Student's Behavior Record – Grades 6 and 9

- a) Suspensions (either in or out-of-school) totaling more than five school days during the previous school year or the proportionally equivalent number of school days during a partial school year and/or
- b) At the discretion of the principal, any student who has had to be reported to the State for possession of a weapon, etc.
- c) Expulsion from another school district during the previous school year or during the school year in which the application is being made and/or
- d) Attendance at an alternative school for behavioral reasons during the previous school year or during the school year in which application has been made
