Dear Parent of a Student in a Non-Public/Private School:

Is a child in your life developing differently or having problems learning? If so, help is available for eligible children.

The Region I Special Education office is conducting a **Child Find** public awareness campaign to locate and provide services for unserved/underserved youth, including migrant and homeless children, with a delay or disability from birth through twenty-one years of age. Children may exhibit physical, mental, language, or emotional difficulties.

How to Make a Referral

- 1. If your child is 5-21 years of age and attends a non-public/private school**—If you suspect that your child has a learning, emotional, physical or cognitive delay you can request an evaluation for special education eligibility. You do this by sending a written request for an evaluation to your school principal. Include your child's name, age, address and suspected disability.
- 2. If your child is ages 3-4** that written request must be sent to the special education department in the town where you live.
- 3. If your child is under the age of 3**—If your child should be crawling, walking or talking but isn't, call for information about resources and services for your child under age 3. The New Jersey Early Intervention System statewide toll-free number is 1-888-NJ-EI-INFO ((1-888-653-4463).
