

IEC (INTERVENTION-ENRICHMENT-CLASS)

Daily plan for maximizing productive time in place of advisory

Purpose: The purpose of this class period is to provide Reading and Math support **(Intervention)** to students that have gaps in learning, or learning difficulties, and who struggle with grade level work. This period also provides an opportunity for other, stronger students to expand learning opportunities and work towards Attaining Level III mastery on STAAR. Grades will be assigned on a Pass/ Needs Improvement Basis.

***Enrichment/Content Periods:** These groups will be rotating every three weeks. Teachers will need a project based lesson plan for students for a three week period. This lesson plan will be repeated for each group that rotates through. The enrichment class may also utilize time as a "study hall", and have the flexibility of collaboration with peers on "homework", or other assignments. The **"Content"** class will be an extremely flexible portion of the rotations. This may include leadership activities, character ed, "theme based" activities (ex.. Red Ribbon Week, Veterans Day, Christmas), resume making, applications, life skills, budgeting, current events/issues, testing strategies..basically whatever YOU find as beneficial for that rotation.

Academic UIL Practice: Once we get closer to the Academic UIL season, we will modify the rotation to allow for practice.
