Minimum Requirements to Apply for the Scholarship

- Participation in meaningful, significant, compassionate, and charitable community service during the years at El Dorado High School.
- Acceptance to next level of education/vocational/professional studies
- Completion of application by April 12, 2019
- Commitment to continue to give back to El Dorado and its community in years to come.

Award:

Total Scholarship fund is \$5,000.00. Winners and amounts awarded will be determined by the Class of 85 scholarship committee. Meaning, the amounts are at the discretion of the committee and will be announced at the Senior Awards Ceremony and will be awarded with proof of graduation and next level of studies.

Evaluation:

- Applicants will be considered and evaluated on their level of significant community and civil service as well as their ability to express the value that their service and efforts has had to their life and community. This is to be submitted in Essay form with application.
