Dear Inglewood Unified School District Parents and Guardians,

The safety, health, and well-being of our students and staff are paramount to Inglewood Unified School District (IUSD). Effective Monday, March 16, 2020, all IUSD schools will be closed to students and visitors for two weeks.

In order to support our students' instructional and wellness needs, the District has created a menu of self-guided learning activities for TK-12 students. Please access these resources on our IUSD website (inglewoodusd.com) by clicking on "IUSD Continuity of Learning Activities" or by picking up a hard copy at the school.

Grades TK-8 students will be issued a learning workbook. Parents will be able to pick up workbooks starting Monday, March 16, 2020 from 1 pm to 5 pm at your child's school. Distribution for TK-8 materials will be at school sites on Tuesday, March 17th from 7:30 am until 4:00 pm. The final distribution for TK-8 materials will be on Wednesday, March 18th at the IUSD District Office at 401 South Inglewood Ave from 7:30 am until 4:00 pm.

For students in Grades 9-12, instructional materials will be provided. Parents will be able to pick up these materials starting on Tuesday, March 17, 2020 from 7:30 am to 4:00 pm at your child's school. Distribution of materials for Grades 9-12 will continue to Wednesday, March 18th at the IUSD District Office from 7:30 am until 4:00 pm.

In addition, meals will be served to all IUSD students between the hours of 9:30 a.m. until 11:30 am each day, starting tomorrow, Monday, March 16, 2020. We will be providing the meals at the following locations: Woodworth-Monroe School, Hudnall Elementary School, Highland Elementary School, and Oak Street Elementary School. There will also be a mobile unit that will serve students at Bennett-Kew Elementary School from 9:45 am - 10:45 am and Worthington Elementary School from 11 am - 12:30 pm. Students may visit ANY of these schools to receive a "take home" meal.
