Stinson named as next MMS Principal

Mayfield Independent School District is proud to announce that current Mayfield Middle School Assistant Principal Kelly Stinson has been named as the next principal of MMS. She will replace Kim Reed who will be moving to the Board of Education office in July.

Stinson is a lifelong Mayfield Cardinal, graduating from Mayfield High School in 2002. She said she is thrilled with this opportunity. "This is my home! I bleed red and black and cannot imagine being anywhere else," Stinson said.

As assistant principal, Stinson helped develop the current school culture at MMS and plans to continue that momentum. "I am most looking forward to working alongside families, students and staff to carry out the greatness that has already been established," she said.

After earning a bachelor's degree in special education from Murray State University in 2006, she returned to Mayfield Schools to begin her career in education. She taught from 2006 until 2013 when she assumed the role of assistant principal. Stinson also graduated from Murray State in 2008 with a master's degree in special education and from University of the Tennessee at Martin with a master's in administration in 2010.
