



Christ the King High School Performing Arts Scholarship

To be considered for a Performing Arts Scholarship, the applicant must:

- list Christ the King as **1st choice** on the TACHS
- submit a well-written 300 word, typed, double-spaced essay describing past related training and accomplishments in the performing arts
- submit a completed application with a copy of the applicant's 6th, 7th and first 8th grade report card

No applicant will be considered until all of the following documents have been submitted in their entirety: essay, 6th, 7th and 8th grade report card, and application. All applications must be postmarked by December 12, 2018.

Auditions are by invitation only. The applicant must be available on Wednesday, January 9, 2019 any time after 3PM. There are no make-up auditions.

Audition Requirements



Audition requirements for a Drama scholarship

The applicant must perform a **memorized** monologue of at least 2 minutes in length. The audition performance should not exceed 4 minutes in total. **Monologues should be from published plays. Original materials should not be used.** The use of props during your audition is not permitted.



Audition requirements for a Dance scholarship

Applicants will be asked to present a solo dance piece (no longer than 3 minutes in length). The piece should be in one of the following styles: Ballet, Modern, Jazz, and/or Contemporary. To be fully prepared, please bring all appropriate dance shoes and attire. Applicants must provide music on an MP3 player (phones may be used, but must be placed in "do not disturb" or "airplane" mode). Speakers will be provided by Christ the King H.S.



Audition requirements for a vocal scholarship

All applicants may sing a song from either the musical theatre or classical repertoire. There will also be some light sight singing. Applicants must bring 2 copies of their sheet music. CK will provide a professional accompanist for you. CD's, Tapes, iPods or other electronic equipment **may** be used as accompaniment, but no vocal tracks are permitted. Your selected piece should be between two and four minutes in total.



Audition requirements for an instrumental scholarship

The Christ the King High School Instrumental Program consists of a concert and marching band, consisting of all wind, brass and percussion instruments. No string instruments will be taught. Applicants will be asked to play two scales of their own choosing and one piece they are currently practicing. Some light sight-reading will be provided. Applicants should bring their own instrument and 2 copies of their sheet music. All percussion instruments are available. Applicants must perform at least 2 minutes but not more than 4 minutes of their selected piece. **Music should be from published sources.**

Note: Christ the King's Performing Arts department offers an interdisciplinary program. Applicants are encouraged to prepare song, monologue and dance pieces to maximize their chance for scholarship consideration.
