This letter is intended to provide an update regarding our elementary redistricting process. Since my January letter, the team of parents serving to create new boundaries for our elementary schools has created a proposed boundary map.

The parents involved in the redistricting team are to be commended for their selfless efforts. They sought to meet the goals set out last fall and we believe they did so. With a new school opening and these new boundaries, hundreds of students will be at a new school in the fall. While there will certainly be transitions for students and staff, we’re excited that each child at the elementary level in Owasso will be at a wonderful elementary school with ample space to learn and thrive thanks to the support from our community.

After the Board of Education approves the new boundaries, our district will provide an address “look up” on our website, so that each family can type in their home address and verify their elementary school. Bus routes will be posted on-line this summer once enrollment for 19-20 is complete.
