Main Street School Property Update

- On January 9, 2019 Circuit Court Judge David Allen ruled in favor of the school district, denying a preliminary injunction filed by the City of Northville to stop demolition of the Main Street School
- The school district is preparing to move forward with demolition and sale of the property to local developer to build four homes on five lots and a pocket park

Amerman Elementary School



- Providing main entrance enhancements for increased security with main entrance vestibule remodeling.
- Removing the existing outdated portable buildings.
- Improving existing classroom and common use toilet rooms by providing new finishes and plumbing fixtures.
- Replacing select windows and doors.

- Upgrading mechanical and electrical infrastructure throughout facility; as well as providing floor/ceiling/wall upgrades to accommodate these improvements
- Transforming the classrooms and learning spaces with mechanical improvements, providing new finishes, and replacing existing furniture with new flexible and collaborative furniture.
- Upgrading the media center area to collaborative learning commons which will allow group learning in a space that will accommodate modern media materials and technology.

Northville High School



- New multipurpose room addition to accommodate student enrollment increase for dining, providing flexible use for extracurricular events/programs and extended learning.
 - New student training /fitness and wellness center addition to accommodate student enrollment increase and to provide students a “fitness center” versus a weight room environment.
 - Renovating/returning the book room to a music room to allow for growth of the music program, and relocating books to another area in the building.
 - Flattening the floor of the Forum to provide versatile floor area for multi-use of the current space and provide an area for large group instruction.
 - Remodeling the robotics room and support spaces to allow for modern STEM teaching and learning.
 - Converting traditional computer room to general science classroom to accommodate the increase in student enrollment and the growing STEM program.
- Providing main entrance enhancements for increased security with main entrance vestibule remodeling.
 - Providing multi-purpose turf at the existing soccer fields for athletics and band that will also reduce maintenance costs.
 - Rebuilding wall at loading dock, correcting drainage and replacing brick at south wall of west vestibule.
 - Replacing select sidewalks and structural slabs.
 - Replace select flooring.
 - Replace pool lockers.
 - Replace skylight system that currently exists over cafeteria corridor area.
 - Replace site lighting to more energy efficient LED fixtures at light poles.

Hillside Elementary School



- ❑ The “new” school will be located on the western side of the existing Hillside Middle School to allow phasing construction without interrupting teaching and learning in the existing facility.
- ❑ School is designed with grade level smaller learning communities to accommodate 1,100 students.
- ❑ Three learning communities are on two levels outfitted with flexible furniture to promote teaming and collaboration – the media center is at level two directly over the administration area affording wonderful views to the north.
- ❑ Enhanced curriculum spaces are located to the south of the academic core and incorporate flexible 1½ story spaces adjacent to open collaboration stations.
- ❑ Dining space is located in the main commons area with direct visibility from the administration area – new server and kitchen is located adjacent in space presently occupied by visual arts.
- ❑ When the new addition is completed, the majority of the existing facility will be removed and new parking and bus/auto loops will be provided in that vacated area.
