Duties

Under the supervision of the Supervisor of Assessment, the incumbent in this position will provide in-depth diagnostic assessments for Deaf and hard of hearing students at the California School for the Deaf, Fremont; write detailed reports; and make recommendations to the school staff as to how best to support the student in their continued academic growth. This person uses appropriate expressive and receptive communication skills, as well as promotes the use of American Sign Language (ASL), attends and/or coordinates IEP meetings, and acts as a resource to students, parents, staff, and the community. The person in this position also reviews records, conducts parent and staff interviews, and plans assessment in appropriate areas, as dictated by school and State policy, and Federal legislation.

Qualifications

Individuals applying for this job must be in possession of, or eligible for:

- 1) California Standard Teaching credential;
- 2) Master's degree from an accredited college or university with a major in Education related to the Deaf and/or Learning Disabled;
- 3) Experience conducting in-depth academic assessments of deaf children;
- 4) Proficiency in sign language.
