1. Mike Brumby, Tift County Foundation For Educational Excellence provided an oral and written report of the Foundation's work throughout Tift County Schools and with Len Lastinger specifically. Excellence In Teaching, Endowed Chairs, Incentive Grants, and Pilot Programs were among his topics.
